2. We charge a \$30 insurance fee to jump at the Boulder Valley Christian Church facility and other designated Above the Bar practice sites. **Make your check payable to "Above the Bar Track Club, Inc"**.

This fee must be paid to the club before you will be allowed to jump.

- 3. You need to fill out one or both of the two attached forms.
 - A Liability release--ALL Must sign!! If you are under 18, have your parent sign it before you come to practice. Everyone must fill in all of the information, and everyone must sign it, even if your parent has signed it.
 - B. CHSAA (High School Students only) required of students to participate in HS Activities outside of school. Have your principal sign it and have the principal keep it on file at the school. Do not bring this to us. This is for the school.
- 4. We will charge a \$5.00 drop-in fee for each vaulter

each time they come to practice and jump. This money will be used to offset the cost of equipment and to reimburse BVCC for the use of the bathroom facilities (Note: Rule #1 No spikes will be worn in the church at any time!)

We practice at the **Church Yard**—Boulder Valley Christian Church (BVCC) at 7100 South Boulder Road, Boulder, CO 80303 just southeast of Boulder. The pit is located by the playground on the south side of the church. The pit is not visible from the road. BVCC is providing us with pole storage on site. We will have a selection of poles available for your use, but it is best if you bring your own poles to jump with. If you break a borrowed pole, a club pole, or a cross bar, you are responsible to replace it.

Directions to the Church Yard from Denver- Colorado Springs-I-25:

I-25 to Highway 36 (Denver –Boulder Road which exits I-25 at Exit 217 about 3 miles north of I-70.) Follow Highway 36 towards Boulder. Exit on McCaslin Blvd and go north about 1.5 miles to South Boulder Road.
