#### **Rules and Regulations**

The rules governing the meet are those of the National Federation of State High School Associations, the Colorado High School Activities Association (CHSAA), as well as the EMAC League.

#### **Entries**

Entries will be submitted online at co.milesplit.com no later than <u>Sunday</u>, <u>April 17<sup>th</sup> at 10pm MST</u>. There will be NO re-seeding if your entries are not submitted on time.

Due to the conversion to electronic timing, each school will be allowed only **THREE** entries per running event and field event and one team per relay event. If you need to run additional athletes beyond your 3 entries, let us know at the coaches meeting, and we will run them in a hand-timed heat after the conclusion of the seeded heats.

## **Coaches Meeting**

There will be a coaches meeting at 2:30 p.m. in front of the press box. Coaches will not be allowed to make substitutions at this time. If you need to run an athlete in the place of another, they will check in and compete as the originally entered athlete.

# **Additional Information**

- 1. Athletes will check in for each running event 15 minutes prior to their event at the middle of the infield. They will be given their lane assignment and hip sticker.
- 2. Athletes will be allowed to warm-up on the infield.
- 3. An athletic trainer, water, and ice will be on hand.
- 4. In case of inclement weather the day of the meet you will be emailed.
- 5. Ribbons will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> Place. Plaques will be awarded to the winning teams. All ribbons and awards will be available immediately following the conclusion of the meet.
- 6. Admission to the meet for spectators will be \$5 for adults and \$2 for students.
