# **Coach Caviness**

Coach Caviness has been a fixture in the Aurora and Colorado State track and cross-country scene since 1955. He started the Aurora relays in 1957 after the University of Denver cancelled their relays at the beginning of the track season. The first Aurora Relays invited fourteen schools. In 1960, 50 teams and 1,200 athletes made the Aurora Relays the "LARGEST SINGLE DAY HIGH SCHOOL TRACK MEET IN THE COUNTRY" – (Rocky Mountain News.)

After 43 years of teaching and coaching with numerous titles and awards Coach Caviness retired in 1992 and the Aurora Relays were renamed the Robert F. Caviness Invitational. The schools in APS are very proud to continue this strong tradition and to host this legendary track and field meet in honor of Coach Caviness.
