General Information

Rangeview High School will host the RHS Qualifier #2 on Saturday May 22nd, 2021 at Aurora Public Schools Stadium. The meet will begin at 9:00 a.m. All running events will be contested as finals, and heats will be seeded from slowest to fastest. Once all entries are received, an updated running schedule will be sent out. Coaches lunches will be provided in the shed on the Northwest corner of the track.

The entry fee is \$300 per team.

Strict restrictions will be in place regarding Covid-related safety. All Coaches and spectators are required to wear masks at all times. Athletes are to be masked at all times EXCEPT when actively competing. We are allowing full teams in the stadium, and it will be up to your school/district guidelines as to how you set up your team camp, which will be located on the grass on the east side of the track, not in the stands. We will have a capacity of 500 spectators, which will be first come, first served. For field events, no athletes outside of the assigned flight will be allowed in the competition area at any time. Athletes will maintain at least 6 ft. of space until the race begins, and become separated immediately following their event. Specifics will be explained at the coaches meeting.

State Qualifying Meet

The RHS Qualifier #1 will be a State Qualifying Meet. Certified officials, electronic timing system, and wind gauges will be utilized. Implements will be weighed in between the Shot Put and Discus areas. Vaulters will be weighed in. Coaching boxes for field events will be designated.

Entries

Each school will be allowed three entries per running/field event and one relay team. Entries will be done through co.milesplit.com. Entries need to be completed by **10am Thursday, May 20th**.
